Academy Rules

Hello and welcome to the Academy!

We're glad to have you on board, and hope that these simple rules make everyone's experience safe and happy!

Rules include but are not limited to:

- Check in! Show up on time, wearing your mask, and ready for your health screening. Your punctuality is appreciated. If you are going to be late you must call the Academy office at 907-677-7529 and speak with a staff member to meet you and conduct your health screening.
- Respect others and their property. Don't touch other people, their props, costumes and/or personal property. Abusive or inappropriate language or conduct will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the program with no refund.
- Every student should bring a mask, a backpack, a lunch, and a three ring binder or report cover for their script, as well as a pencil and highlighter. Please bring these items every day of Academy!
- We will be outside all day! We recommend bring layers as Alaska weather is unpredictable, and keeping extra layers in a backpack. Wear comfortable, appropriate clothing and closed toe shoes that allow freedom of movement for all rehearsals. Shoes must be worn at all times unless instructed otherwise. NO sandals, slip-ons, hats, bare midriffs or spaghetti strap shirts.
- Masks are required unless you are told otherwise by a staff member.
- Long hair must be kept pulled back off the face.
- Place lunches & bags in their assigned area.
- Food and drink are not allowed, except at lunch. The only exception is water in a non-glass, sealable container.
- Do not chew gum, either onstage or off.
- Warm-ups are required for all students. The body and voice are important instruments, participation in warm-ups helps you avoid physical injury and vocal stress. If you have a medical condition that prohibits you from participating, please have a note from a doctor. A serious illness/condition may prohibit your participation in a show.
- We are a non-smoking company. If you are underage and caught smoking, this (and all illegal activities) will be reported to your parents/guardians, and could result in your removal from the Academy with no refund.
- The Academy office areas are off-limits to students.
- Cell phones are not allowed in rehearsals or classes.
- The Academy is not responsible for lost or stolen items, please leave all valuables at home.
- During rehearsals and performances, you are responsible for your entrances and exits, do not rely on others to come and get you. Stay focused on the show.
- Visitors are not allowed at Academy or backstage during dress rehearsals or performances.
- Be courteous and respectful to your tech staff and crew. A thank you goes a long way to these hard working people who are trying to make you look good on stage.
- Cameras or recording devices are not allowed at performances. DVD's will be made available for purchase and there will be an opportunity to take photos.
- Unless listed on your conflict sheet or Covid related, missing rehearsals may result in reassignment of your part or your removal from the show. Cast and crew are required to attend all rehearsals and performances.
- Tickets will be sold online only and will not be available at the door for performances.
- You may be required to provide the following items, including, but not limited to: Pants or skirt Socks or Tights Shoes Please do not purchase any items without first checking with your director!
